

New Student 2024-2025 FAFSA Checklist Financial Aid



Create your <u>FSA ID</u> (username and password). All individuals are **required** to have a verified FSA ID, and this can take 3-5 business days. Do **this** before filling out your FAFSA.

Go to <u>Student Aid</u> and start your portion of the 2024-2025 FAFSA by selecting the "Start New Form" button, or scan the QR code at the top right corner to go to the main Student Aid website.

Make sure GNTC's Federal School Code of **004024** is included on your FAFSA.

Follow instructions provided by U.S. Department of Education to invite a contributor(s) or electronically sign and submit your FAFSA. Contributors are a spouse or parent, if necessary.

Double check to make sure you submitted your FAFSA (as opposed to saving your application). A successful submission results in a confirmation email. Applications not submitted will be deleted after 45 days.

For state aid only (HOPE Programs):

Create or login to <u>GAFutures</u>. Submit your <u>GSFAPP Application</u>.

What's next?

- If you applied for federal aid, the U.S. Department of Education will process your application and submit this to GNTC, provided our school code is entered. Because the FAFSA has changed, GNTC will not receive your information before late April. GNTC will review your 2024-2025 FAFSA and request any additional documentation required for your financial aid file, if needed. The Financial Aid Office will review your application in the order it was received.
- If you applied for state aid, the Financial Aid Office will receive notification and will review your application in the order it was received.
- > Check your MyGNTC Account for estimated award information.
- > Check your student email for important updates.
